New Sites in Delaware, Maryland, and Virginia

PrePass recently opened four new bypass facilities:

- One on the US-301 NB near Middletown, DE - our first site in the state of Delaware;
- One on the I-70 WB near West Friendship, MD - our second site in Maryland; and
- Two on the I-64 EB and WB near Sandston, VA - our 15th and 16th sites in Virginia.

Attention Florida Drivers

The six PrePass Ag interdiction facilities in Florida are in very close proximity to PrePass weigh stations, so it is important to pay careful attention to your transponder signals when driving in these locations. Approval to bypass the Florida Ag stations is granted only through a separate application process. If your company has not received notification from the state of Florida that they are approved for this program, you can expect your vehicles to receive red lights at the agricultural interdiction facilities even if you receive green lights at the weigh stations.
