Avoid Service Interruptions

Without the proper billing address on file, you run the risk of a temporary interruption of your PrePass service. Undeliverable invoices may lead to account deactivation and inability to bypass. If you've moved recently or have stopped receiving your PrePass invoice, please contact 1-800-773-7277 (opt. 5) to verify we have your correct billing address on file.

Utah Oversize Permits

If you are permitted for oversize or overweight travel in Utah, please contact PrePass Customer Service at 1-800-773-7277 (opt. 6) to arrange submitting copies of these permits.

Faster Safety Verification

Beginning in March 2007, PrePass began verifying carrier safety ratings on a monthly basis. PrePass verifies safety ratings of participating carriers through data from the U.S. Department of Transportation's Inspection Selection System (ISS2). Late last year, ISS2 data updates became available monthly, making it feasible to increase the frequency of the verification cycle.

Performing these verifications monthly rather than quarterly will help ensure PrePass customers are bypassing based on the most accurate, up-to-date safety information about their company. By pulling in only those carriers that demand the most attention, PrePass is helping to make our roadways safer for everyone.

Red Lights in New Mexico?

If you're getting pulled in to weigh stations in New Mexico, the reason may be that we do not have a copy of your New Mexico Tax ID Permit. Contact PrePass Customer Service at 1-800-773-7277 (opt. 6) to verify we have your permit on file.

Returning Transponders

Your PrePass transponder should be returned if not assigned to a vehicle. Any transponder inactive for longer than 30 days could incur an automatic \$100 "lost device" charge. Avoid this fee by returning all of your unassigned PrePass transponders to:
