## Returning Transponders

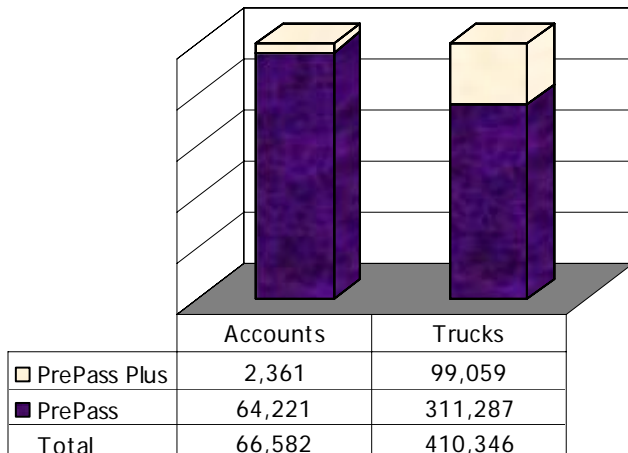
Any transponder inactive for more than 30 days could incur an automatic \$100 "lost device" charge. To avoid this fee, your PrePass transponders should be returned if they are not assigned to any vehicles. Ship your unassigned PrePass transponders to:
