



## Bypass Restrictions

Revised: 9/9/2011

### Introduction

This pamphlet lists restricted cargo types for each PrePass state. When approaching a PrePass facility, you must pull in if your cargo satisfies any of the restricted criteria listed for that state, even if you receive a green light on your transponder.

Please keep this pamphlet in your vehicle as a quick reference. Failure to voluntarily pull in when hauling restricted cargo may result in prosecution, fines, and/or suspension of bypass privileges.

### Special Notes

#### **Colorado:**

(Dumont **WB/EB**, Ft. Collins **SB**, Lamar **SB**, Limon **WB**, Monument **NB**, Trinidad **NB**)  
These ports have exits off the interstate before you reach the port. If you take this exit, you must report to the port when you reenter the interstate, even if you received a green light on your transponder.

#### **Maryland:**

Trucks receiving a red light must report to the static scale and disregard ramp sorter signals.

#### **Ohio and West Virginia:**

An Alliance for Uniform Hazmat Transportation license is required if hauling hazardous materials/waste. Follow in-cab signal. Disregard state signs to pull into weigh station.

### Changeable Message Signs

*PrePass-equipped trucks should disregard electronic road signs.  
Drivers are to follow the signal given by the in-cab device.*

*Bypass at these sites is by separate approval only.  
If you do not receive a bypass signal, you must pull into the station.*

## Bypass Restrictions by State

If a driver receives a green light, and any of the following conditions apply, the driver must pull into the inspection facility.

### ALABAMA

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)
- Agricultural loads
- Bulk fuel loads
- Livestock loads

### ARIZONA

- **Oversize/Overweight** (unless Class E permit)
- Fuel import loads
- Placarded Hazmat and Hazwaste loads

### ARKANSAS

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)
- Placarded Hazmat and Hazwaste loads

### CALIFORNIA

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)
- Agricultural loads - only pull in if directed by enforcement facility signs

### COLORADO

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads) **except LCVs operating with an annual permit & receive a green light**
- Temporary permit to haul hazardous waste/materials

### DELAWARE

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### FLORIDA

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### FLORIDA AGRICULTURAL INSPECTION FACILITIES

- (Yulee I-95, White Springs I-75, Live Oak I-10, Pensacola I-10)
- Approved Carriers: Agricultural loads
  - Non-Approved Carriers: **ANY LOAD**

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads) except LCVs operating with a KTA permit-South Haven Site Only

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### MARYLAND

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### MICHIGAN

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### MISSISSIPPI

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads) except manufactured housing haulers approved by the MS DOT
- Private carriers transporting taxable petroleum products

### MISSOURI

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### MONTANA

- **Overweight** (even permitted loads)
- **Overwide** (greater than 9 ft.)
- **Overheight** (greater than 14 ft. 6 in.)

### NEBRASKA

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### NEW MEXICO

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### OHIO

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)
- Unlicensed Hazmat

### OKLAHOMA

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### SOUTH CAROLINA

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### TENNESSEE

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### TEXAS

- **Oversize/Overweight** (even permitted loads)

### UTAH

- **Livestock & Agriculture** (including bees)
- **Non-Divisible Oversize/Overweight Loads**
